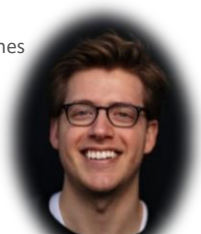
**LINA BONDEARENKO** *Joined SDM in Feb 2026*
